Subject: RE: Star-of-Bethlehem (*Ornithogalum umbellatum* subsp. *campestre*)

Dear Charles,

The field highlighted in blue was very species-rich and had dozens of Early-purple Orchids (*Orchis mascula*) sprinkled about, which was very nice to see. Interestingly on the stream bank, approximately marked in red, there were several patches of Mossy Clubmoss (*Selaginella kraussiana*). This primitive plant was once used, I believe, in wreath making and as a result is found growing in many churchyards. It is very unusual to find it growing in a wild situation and this is the first time I have seen it growing along a stream bank.
